General rules **UK only** - 19th July 2021 onwards



LOTUS ON TRACK



Access & Arrival

- Access is from 07.30 (Evening events from 15.00)
- Bring a face covering - it will still be required at sign on.
- Whilst it is no longer mandatory to wear a face covering, we would strongly encourage their use, particularly in busy enclosed areas.
- We will continue to take registration forms on-line in advance of events with those who have submitted them 48hrs before an event being offered an on-line briefing still - this reduces risk as well as saving you time.



Hygiene & Safety

- We recommend that you continue to observe social distancing, especially with those you do not know.
- We recommend that you clean your hands after each activity - Hand sanitiser will continue to be available.
- Whilst it is no longer mandatory to wear a face covering, we would strongly encourage their use, particularly in busy enclosed areas.
- We still recommend that you do not share equipment with anyone else on the day.



On-circuit

- Where a LoT instructor is a passenger both the driver and our instructor must wear full face crash helmets.
- Crash helmets are no longer available to hire but you can purchase one online from companies such as Demon Tweaks.

IMPORTANT: You must not attend an event if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, or you are required to self-isolate under Government guidelines.
