

TRACK DAY RULES COVID-19



LOTUS ON TRACK

General rules - 2022 - UK & Europe

(We hope that these rules won't be required in 2022 but by publishing them up front you are aware of the worst case before booking.)



Access & Arrival

- Access is between 07.30 - 18.30 - no overnight stays are permitted.
- **One of the following may be required to attend this event:**
 - A fully complete UK or EU vaccination certificate
 - Proof of a negative PCR or negative antigenic test less than 48h old
 - A recovery certificate (test positive from at least 11 days and under 6 months)
- Anyone not registered in advance may will not be admitted.
- Bring a face mask - it will be compulsory at sign on and may be compulsory in other or all areas of the venue.



Hygiene & Safety

- **Observe social distancing rules**
- **Clean your hands after each activity - Hand sanitiser will be available**
- We recommend that you wear a face mask in the paddock
- Respect the social distance signs on the floor
- Respect one-direction lines when queuing for the event registration or any other activities
- Do not share equipment with anyone else on the day



On-circuit

- Where a passenger is carried both occupants may need to wear a full face crash helmet. If a passenger wears an open face helmet they may need to wear a mask.
- Crash Helmets will not be available to hire - at least until June 2022

IMPORTANT: You must not attend an event if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, or you are required to self-isolate under Government guidelines.
